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PROFILE OF CHILDREN DISPLAYING CALLOUS-UNEMOTIONAL BEHAVIORS

- Callous-unemotional (CU) traits refer to low levels of guilt, empathy, and caring for others.
- Children displaying high levels of CU behaviors are at greater risk for developing more severe conduct problems (CP).
- This study showed that children with higher levels of CP and CU behaviors are more emotionally dysregulated, BUT displayed better cognitive performance relative to children with only high levels of CP.

PREDICTING TREATMENT GAINS FOR CHILDREN WITH ADHD

- The Head-Toes-Knees-Shoulder (HTKS)
 task is a game similar to "Simon Says"," and
 is a valid measure of executive functioning
 (EF) for young children.
- EF includes a set of higher level cognitive skills.
- The Summer Treatment Program for Pre-K (STP-PreK) is an evidence based treatment for children with ADHD and other related
 disorders.
- This study found that children with better EF before treatment, as measured by the HTKS, are more responsive to the STP-PreK and make greater academic improvements.

SELF-REGULATION & ADHD SYMPTOMS

- There are 2 symptom domains within ADHD: hyperactivity/impulsivity and inattention.
- Many children with ADHD have difficulty with self-regulation-both executive functioning (EF) and emotion regulation (ER).
- This study found that EF is related to inattention AND hyperactivity/impulsivity, while ER was mostly related to hyperactivity/impulsivity.



COST EFFECTIVENESS OF PARENT-CHILD INTERACTION THERAPY

- This study examined the cost-effectiveness of standard parent-child interaction therapy (PCIT) and three adaptations: intensive-PCIT (I-PCIT), small group PCIT, and large group PCIT.
 - Standard PCIT was the least cost-effective option in reducing child disruptive behaviors and in increasing child compliance.
- Large group PCIT was the most overall cost-effective option, followed by I-PCIT.
